In addition to online classes that you can work on each week when the time is best for you, we will have a few locally-focused and hands-on learning labs (evenings) to supplement the online classes! - The course runs from January - April, 2023.
- The cost of the program is \$200. (There are scholarships for locals and discounts for county and CSU staff for a 50% discount.)

SEED SAVING CLASSES

- Saturday, October 22, 9 am till noon, Naturita Library.
- Saturday, November 4, 10 am till 1 pm, Ridgway Library.

Learn how to save seeds from plants you like in order to replant them and get new plants that come ‘true to type’. Seed saving requires just a little bit of knowledge and is fun and very rewarding! This class will benefit any gardener or small farmer.

We will also have a Seed Share so bring seeds to share. They can be seeds that you have left from seeds you bought or from seeds you collected. If you don’t have seeds to share, you can still get seeds—we have plenty to share!

Both classes are in support of local Seed Libraries and are free BUT you can give a donation to help us continue our work.
