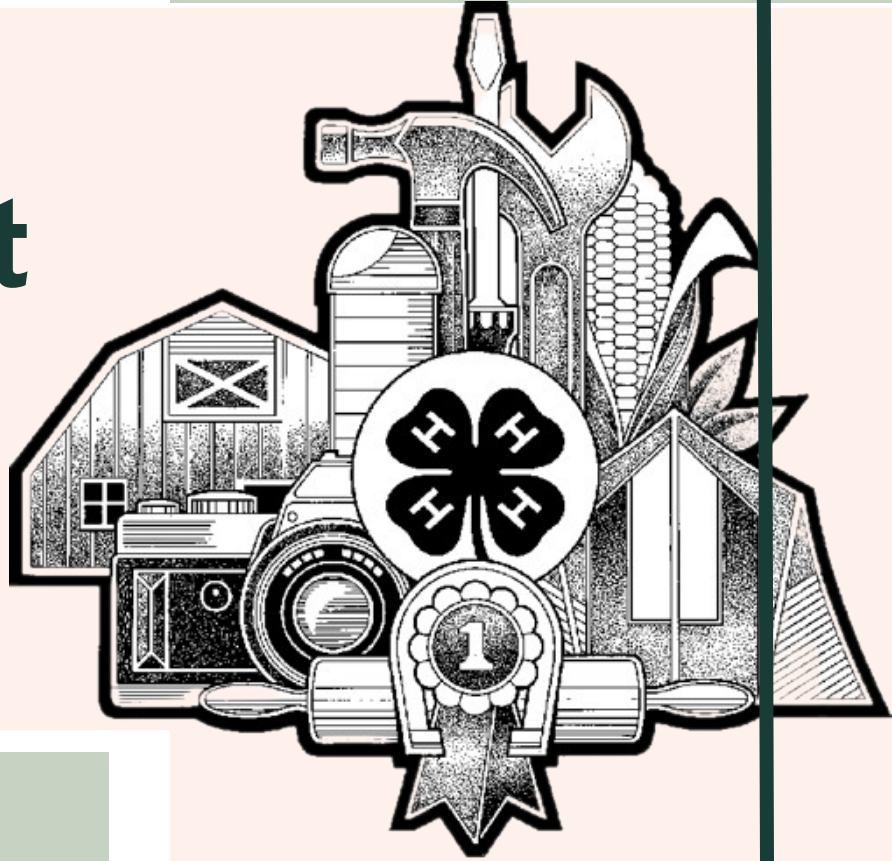

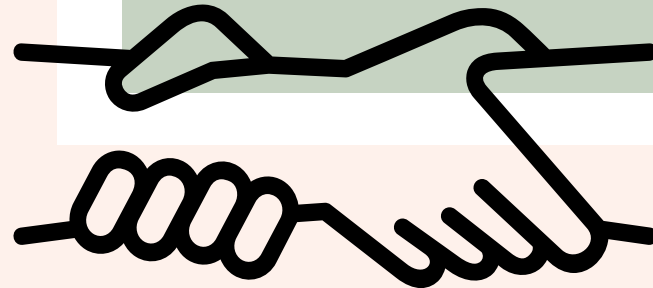
To prepare for Lead to Change at Ignite by 4-H teens are encouraged to identify the following prior to the event:
